ENROLMENT PROCESS

Aspiring Students have the opportunity to enroll into their Programs of choice either in person or virtually online. Students are encouraged to enroll a minimum of 6 weeks prior to the commencement date to ensure all materials are arranged on time. Late enrollments may be available based on available seats however materials may require additional time to arrive. A one time enrollment fee of \$150.00 applies to all first time Students. As an incentive to enrolling on time, Students can expect to have the enrollment fee waived.

STEP 1 – Review this Program Guide to ensure the Program content and expected outcomes are in line with your goals. An Admissions Coordinator or the Director will be more than happy to help answer any questions you may have about your Program of choice. A phone call or in person tour can be scheduled at your convenience.

STEP 2 – Review Program schedule to decide which type suits you, full-time or part-time studies. Full-Time schedules are typically weekdays Monday to Friday 930am to 330pm, while Part-Time schedules are typically 2 evenings 6pm to 9pm and a weekend, for example Sunday 10am to 4pm. Choose a start date. Our programs have multiple entry points making it simple to hop into an upcoming start date that suits you.

STEP 3 – Review the Program fees and payment options. Choose your preferred form of payment and a payment plan that best suits you. Students that require Acceptance letters for RESP, Third Party Grants or Second Career funding may request the letter.
